Critique: This large format (8.5 x 0.7 x 8.5 inches, 2.2 pounds) trade paperback edition of "Exploring Wine Regions - Mexico: Exploring Mexico's Quality Wines and Phenomenal Cuisine" is profusely illustrated with 600 photographic images as it explores Mexico's regions of Valle de Guadalupe (including Ensenada), Guanajuato (including San Miguel de Allende) and Queretaro. Extensive resources are provided for wine lovers who want to know where to go, what to look for, and how to discover their favorite wines. A superbly produced and impressively informative pictorial travel guide through Mexico's wine country, "Exploring Mexico's Quality Wines and Phenomenal Cuisine Exploring Wine Regions - Mexico" is especially and unreservedly recommended for personal, professional, community, and college/university library Travel Guide: Mexico collections. It should be noted that this trade paperback edition of "Exploring Wine Regions - Mexico" from the International Exploration Society is also readily available in a digital book format (Kindle, \$9.95).
